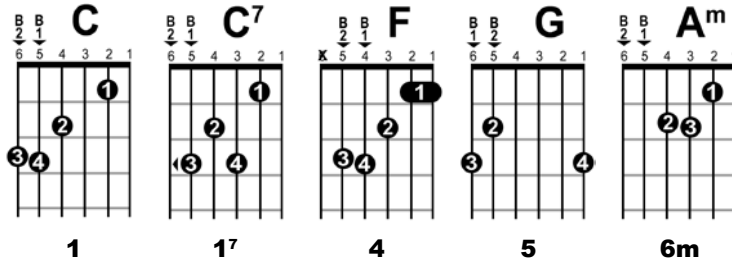


O Mary, Don't You Weep
